Turn up the volume on climate change
The Amazon region and its world-renowned biodiversity are under threat from agriculture, climate change and mining. The World Association for Christian Communication (WACC), Grupo Comunicarte and the ALER Network of Amazonian communicators in Brazil, Colombia and Ecuador are training citizen journalists to create climate-focused stories for a weekly community radio broadcast.

Tree guardians for life
In Colombia, PWRDF partner ILSA recognizes that tree preservation is integral to the fragile Páramos, a moorland ecosystem in the mountains that is the source of 70% of the country's fresh water. ILSA works with women to preserve seeds that are at risk of disappearing, which not only threatens the environment but also has a devastating impact on food security. Planting seeds for local growth
PWRDF is working with other Canadian members of the ACT Alliance to support climate action in Eastern and Southern Africa. The Locally Led Climate Fund (LLCF) engages partners to determine their local climate needs and design their own solutions, with funding and other support as needed. Tree-planting is included in all regions.

In this year's World of Gifts campaign, PWRDF celebrates its many partners who are planting trees. In 2022, the Anglican Alliance launched the Communion Forest, a world-wide campaign to engage people on the importance of caring for creation through greening and reforestation initiatives. As a founding member of the Anglican Alliance, PWRDF is encouraging parishes and dioceses to join in. In Ottawa, the PWRDF working group launched Branches of Hope. The Diocese of Ottawa provided tree seedlings to be planted locally while the campaign raised \$5,000 to fund the planting and maintenance of 1,250 local tree seedlings for PWRDF partner St. Jude Family Projects in Uganda.
